Isabel Di Carlo (Venezuela)	Isabel is Environmental Issues Coordinator and Chief Negotiator for Climate Change. She is also in charge of multilateral policy and global affairs, in the Vice Ministry for Multilateral Issues of the Foreign Ministry of Venezuela. Additionally she acts as liaison with the Bonn-based UN environmental agencies (Climate Change, Desertification, IPBES, and Migratory Species).
T. Jayaraman (India)	T. Jayaraman was trained as a theoretical physicist and worked professionally in the discipline for more than 20 years. Over the last 15 years he has worked on issues of science and society, especially from the point of view of policy. He has been actively worked on issues related to climate change and has engaged with academia, civil Society and government on climate policy over the last ten years. He has been on the delegation of the Govt of India to the IPCC sessions in the AR6 cycle and consults actively for the Govt of India on policy matters in climate change
Meena Raman (Malaysia)	Legal Advisor and Head of Programs of Malaysia-based Third World Network (TWN). She is President of Friends of the Earth, Malaysia and works with indigenous peoples, farmers and fishermen in Malaysia.
Doreen Stabinsky (USA)	Doreen is currently Professor of Global Environmental Politics at the College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor, Maine. Her primary area of research, policy analysis and advocacy is at the nexus between climate change, agriculture and food security. Doreen has represented various NGOs and the College of the Atlantic in numerous intergovernmental forums, including the UN Convention on Biological Diversity, the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change, the UN Food and Agriculture Organization, the UN Commission on Sustainable Development, and the World Trade Organization. Doreen studied economics at the undergraduate level and has a Ph.D. in Genetics from the University of California at Davis.
Maria Aljishi (Saudi Arabia)	After being in Industry for many years. Maria joined the Ministry of Energy in Saudi Arabia as a climate negotiator working on Article 6 of the Paris Agreement. She has since been speaking in the Article 6 room on behalf of the Like Minded Developing Countries which is a group of 24 countries who share similar views on matter relating to climate change. The group includes Bolivia, Saudi Arabia, China, India and many others representing more than 50% of the world's population.
